

PUBLIC HEARING  
January 24, 2018

The Hamlin Town Board held a public hearing on January 24, 2018 for the Creation of the Rt. 18 Clarkson Hamlin Joint Water District in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Rd., Hamlin, New York. The hearing was called to order at 6:30 pm by Supervisor Peters who explained the location of the fire exits and defibrillator for those present.

Present: Councilperson Baxter, Councilperson Voelkl, Councilperson Maier, Councilperson Rose, and Supervisor Peters.

Also present: Scott Mattison, Chatfield Engineers residents: Mr. & Mrs. Scott, Mr. & Mrs. Gaspar, Tim Nash

Scott Mattison from Chatfield Engineer briefly discussed formation of the water district to completion.

It was asked about keeping your well, tapping in, contractors, and cutting driveways.

- Wells would have to be split off, would need to get an easement from Water Authority at the cost of \$500.00, so they could go on the property once a year to inspect the split at \$80.00 a year.
- When the line goes though you should come in and sign up for a tap-in, if you don't it could cost you between \$2,500.00 -2,800.00 at a later date.
- For contractors, the people have to get themselves and if a couple of you go together you might get a cheaper rate.
- The driveways will be cut with a saw so it will be a nice neat cut.
