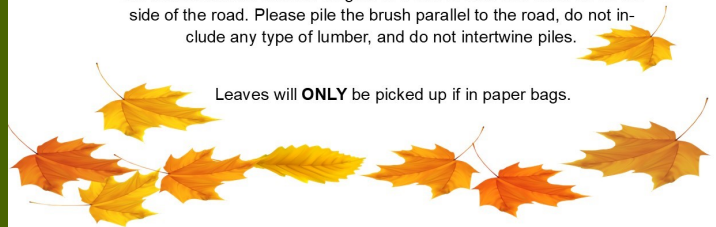
Brush Pick Up Starts

October 7th

There will be **ONE** pass down each road.

The brush must be cut into lengths of 8 feet or less and must be on the side of the road. Please pile the brush parallel to the road, do not include any type of lumber, and do not intertwine piles.

Leaves will **ONLY** be picked up if in paper bags.

October 3rd and 4th— 10am to 7pm

October 5th— 8am to 4pm

Items containing gas tanks must have the tank removed, all gas tanks or drums must be clean, empty and cut in half. Debris must be cut into 8' lengths, large items like hot tubs must be cut in quarters.

Is the package shiny or does it make a crinkly/crunchy sound in your hand? If yes, do NOT recycle in the NexTrex® bin.
