**Budget for the Town of Hamlin for the Fiscal Year 2016 Public Hearing**

**PUBLIC QUESTIONS**

Sherry Dobson wanted to address the Huntington Private Park Special District. She indicated that there are several projects that should be addressed due to the surplus of \$24,000 that is on account for projects for the district. She indicated they pay on a special line item on their taxes so they would like to see things done. Her biggest concern is to have the crosswalks done so the kids don't get hit by cars. They would like to see a basketball court since the kids play in the street instead now. They are concerned that they don't see security come through the area like they should. They appreciate the new entrance signs and they plan to get top soil to put around them. She wanted to know how the break up of the budget is to who gets the money, the guys doing the work or the Parks Superintendent. It was indicated to her that it is just for the guys that do the work over there. Supervisor Peters indicated that he did pass on all the requests that Sherry has made to the Parks Superintendent and will let him know again her concerns. He would also like to set up a committee in the Spring with other members from the area to go over what the needs are and what they can do with the money that is there for the use.

With no one else wishing to address the board the Public Hearing was closed.

**1396 Lake Road Resolution Public Hearing**

**PUBLIC QUESTIONS**

A report from the Building Code Enforcement Officer on September 25 indicating the violations found for the property at 1396 Lake Road. The Fire Marshal did a report on October 16 when he was called to the property because there were some individuals on the property from the maintenance group. He was able to go inside and see even more deterioration happening then the ones visible from the outside of the property. The Supervisor sent letters to the property owners and the Maintenance Group. There has

been no response from them. They have refused or not picked up the certified letters that were sent out. There has been phone conversations and letters and notices posted trying to communicate with the owner of the property and the maintenance group. The Building Inspector and the Fire Marshal both agree that they believe that the building is unsafe and will not be able to be restored.

With no one else wishing to address the board and no owner of record and the property maintenance company appearing to discuss the property the Public Hearing was closed.
