Commercial Site Plan for Gary Shadders for a woodworking shop named Salmon Creek woodworking to be located at 47 King Street. A Public Hearing was scheduled for June 5th.

Under discussion: Public Hearing for the new Solar Law. There were no negative comments. Lake level discussion. The asbestos concerns and issues surrounding the Duffy Mott Building at 65 Orchard Avenue. Town Attorney Ken Licht commented that Ricky Shute may be a possible owner.

Nathan Pacelli reported on the Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting:

The only item on the agenda was a sketch conference for a new 10' x 5' roof sign to be placed at 1468 Lake Road East Fork. It was determined that a variance was not required.

Steve Rutherford reported on the Fishing Advisory Board Meeting:

The tourist industry is using brochures, online messaging and social media as ways to reach the public. The hit rates to Lake Ontario are down 31%, possibly due to the bad press of Lake Ontario. E-mails from the brochures stayed the same but have increased for the last 4 years. 45% of all the hits were from female gender. June 3rd, Powder Mill Park, Monroe County Fishing Derby. Sponsored by Conservation and the Fishing Advisory Board. Ages 8-16. There will be prizes for largest and smallest fish, and 1st boy and 1st girl to catch a fish.

FRIENDS OF HAMLIN BEACH REPORT

Despite a cool, rainy day, over 60 volunteers took part in I Love My Park Day at Hamlin Beach State Park on May 6th. Projects included beach clean-up, cleaning out and weeding flower beds, raking out the horseshoe pits, and cleaning up and preparing the Recreation hall for the upcoming camping season. Statewide close to 8,000 people volunteered at 125 state parks, historic sites and public lands across the state.

The boat launch portion of Yanty Marsh is open to the public again. Camping opened on the 19th.

There is now a \$6 per car entrance fee on weekends. On June 7th that increases to \$7 every day of the week.
