

Hamlin Public Hearing

The Hamlin Town Board held a Public Hearing in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Road, Hamlin, New York. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Supervisor Peters. LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 442-3 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF HAMLIN TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN MEDICAL AND PRESCRIPTION DRUG EXPENSES BE EXCLUDED FROM THE INCOME LIMITATION FOR THE SENIOR CITIZEN REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION

Section 1. Section 442-3 (Grant Exemption) of Article II (Senior Citizens Exemption) of Chapter 442 (Taxation) of the Code of the Town of Hamlin is hereby amended by adding a final sentence which provides as follows:

Such income shall be offset by all medical and prescription drug expenses actually paid which were not reimbursed or paid for by insurance.

With no one wishing to address the board the Public Hearing was closed.
