

Conservation Board Meeting *Minutes*
September 26, 2005
7:00pm

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Hamlin Conservation Board was held at the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Road, Hamlin and was called to order at 7:00pm by the Chairman Dave Walch with the location of the fire exits explained for those present.

Present: Merritt Ackles, James Doan, Craig Goodrich, Frank Marando, Tammy Palumbo, Glenn Quetschenbach and Dave Walch.

Also present: Town Board Liaison Paul S. Rath, residents Denny Roach, James E. Krempasky and Tom Jensen.

A motion was made by James Doan, seconded by Craig Goodrich to approve the minutes of the August 22, 2005 meeting. Members polled, all ayes. Motion carried, minutes approved.

Public Forum Opened

REPORTS

Craig Goodrich gave a report on the September 6, 2005 Planning Board meeting. Craig reported that Mr. O'Dell of Westphal Road was seeking lot combination approval and was referred to the Zoning Board for a variance for lot size. Andy Simpson of Moscow Road was seeking Conceptual Site Plan approval. Dave Martin was seeking Re-subdivision approval for the Chris Martin Subdivision on Lake Road East Fork and Mr. Enos was present to discuss a deck addition to the break wall on the lake. He was referred to the Zoning Board for a variance.

Craig Goodrich gave a report on the September 19, 2005 Zoning Board meeting. Craig reported that Sunset Builders were seeking several lot size variances for a subdivision on Lake Road. They were denied. Mr. Rasbach of Shore Acres was seeking variances for a detached garage and they were granted. The Hamlin Volunteer Ambulance Corp. was granted variances for a new sign. Mr. Fey was scheduled a Public Hearing for variances for a shed and Mr. and Mrs. Simpson were scheduled a Public Hearing for variances to construct a Pole Barn on vacant property on Moscow Road.

Tammy Palumbo gave a report on the September 12, 2005 Town Board meeting. Tammy reported that the Fall Brush Pick up will be the end of October. Funding was approved to seal and line the basketball courts. SEQR determination and DEC permits were completed for the West Creek Tributary cleaning and restoration. The Building Department reported several deck and pool permits being issued. Tammy also noted that a member of the Hamlin Ambulance went to New Orleans to help after Hurricane Katrina.

Merritt Ackles reported that there was no Harbor Management meeting this month and they are not sure of when the next meeting will be.

Merritt Ackles gave a report on the September 12, 2005 Fishing Advisory Board meeting. Merritt reported that the DEC plans to conduct a 2-year survey on tributaries and streams in the area to get information regarding fish and habitats. It will start late September 2005 through May 2006. They will have people posted at various tributaries and along the lake collecting data. They reported that the fishing was good this summer and the Fishing Derby results were given. Merritt also noted that he and several other shoreline residents received a survey regarding the protection of Lake Ontario's water quality.

Dave Walch gave a report on the September 21, 2005 EMC meeting. Dave reported that the meeting was a Presentation of Nature Photography. The photos were judged and Maggie Brooks presented the awards. A Hamlin resident was one of the winners.
