

Conservation Board Meeting *Minutes*

A motion was made by Jeanine Klopp, seconded by Craig Goodrich to approve the minutes from the September 25, 2006 meeting as recorded. Members polled, all ayes. Motion carried, minutes approved.

**REPORTS**

Craig Goodrich gave a report on the October 2, 2006 Planning Board meeting. Craig reported that there was a Public Hearing for Mr. Riggs to operate an auto sales/repair shop on Lake Road. That was approved. Mr. And Mrs. Mastrodonato had a Public Hearing to open a restaurant on Lake Road East Fork. That was approved. A Public Hearing for Preliminary Site Plan approval for the Bromley Subdivision was held. That was approved. The Special Use Permit for the MET Tower on Redman Road was approved. Mr. Cleaveland was scheduled a Public Hearing for Site Plan approval on Monroe Orleans County Line Road. A Public Hearing was scheduled for the Rath Subdivision. Mr. Clark was referred to the Zoning Board for variances for 5733 Wautoma Beach Road. Lifetime Assistance was scheduled a Public Hearing for Site Plan approval for 1 Traciann Drive.

Craig Goodrich gave a report on the October 16, 2006 Zoning Board meeting. Craig reported that Lifetime Assistance received variances for 1 Traciann Drive. Steve Liotta received variances for a pond in the R-L district on Lake Road West Fork. Mr. DeFrank was rescheduled for variances for a 2-story barn. Kevin Clark was scheduled a Public Hearing for variances for 5733 Wautoma Beach Road. It was determined that Ms. Bausili did not need variances for a fence on Wautoma Beach Road.

Some discussion took place on the clearing that is being done at the Heritage Woods site.

Craig Goodrich discussed a letter from the DEC regarding the Bromley Subdivision located on Beachwood Park. The DEC is very concerned with the project and is not going to issue permits for the north lot. Craig will contact the DEC and invite them to the November meeting for discussion. Town Board Liaison Paul Rath stated that the Planning Board did explain that DEC permits would be required for this project.

Mark Reeves gave a report on the October 10, 2006 Town Board meeting. Mark reported that there were several residents there to speak during the Public Forum regarding the MET towers and Wind Turbines. They had a petition opposing the Wind Turbines. A L.O. C. Initiative letter was discussed and a speaker would be at the December 11, 2006 meeting. Junk vehicles were discussed. Heritage Woods was discussed. A Wind Tower Committee is being organized. A Public Hearing for the 2007 Budget is scheduled for October 30.

Merritt Ackles gave a report on the October 9, 2006 Fishing Advisory Board meeting. Merritt reported that a guest brought in pictures of the Irondequoit Creek erosion and was asking for suggestions on restoring it to its original condition. He was given some people to contact. A proposal letter to Mayor Duffy in favor of the SUNY Brockport research center was discussed. They are working on a website.

Dave Walch gave a report on the October 18, 2006 EMC meeting. Dave reported that they had a speaker that has created the Rochester Sound Scape Society. They are concerned with noise and its effects on the environment. They are working on creating policies regarding noise in communities. Studies have been done on the effects of noise on children and their grades. Our current code on noise was discussed. Town Board Liaison Paul Rath stated that noise in agricultural areas is exempt in our code.
