

Conservation Board Meeting *Minutes*

The regular scheduled meeting of the Hamlin Conservation Board was held at the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Road, Hamlin and was called to order at 7:00pm by the Chairman Dave Walch with the location of the fire exits and AED explained for those present.

The Marseglia Subdivision received Final Subdivision approval. Discussion took place on the Country Creek Phase II. The Board agreed that Final plans needed to be submitted for approval.

Craig Goodrich did not attend the October 15, 2007 Zoning Board meeting. Nothing to report.

Tom Breslawski gave a report on the October 9, 2007 Town Board meeting. Tom reported that there was a Public Hearing for the Child Safety Zone Law prior to the meeting. During the Public Forum there was a lot of Wind Tower comments. There will be a Public Hearing on October 29 at 6:00pm for the Budget. Having a curfew in the Town was discussed. Re-appointment letters are due by November 15 to the Town Board. Mark Reeves mentioned the Wind Tower workshop on November 14.

Dave Walch gave a report on the October 17, 2007 EMC meeting. Dave reported that a member from the Water Bureau was present to discuss a long-term water treatment rule mandating that all water supplies must be covered. The water is not being treated after it leaves the reservoirs. They discussed not using the Cobbs Hill and Highland Park water supply any more. No funding is available at this time.
