

Conservation Board Meeting *Minutes*

The regular scheduled meeting of the Hamlin Conservation Board was held at the Hamlin Town Hall and was called to order at 7:00 PM by the Chairperson Dave Walch with the location of the fire exits explained for those present.

A motion was made by Jeanine Klopp, seconded by Ed Evans with the correction to Ed's report that the prisoner was there until 1946 and the correction to Nick's report that it decreased the immediate threat in Hamlin to approve the minutes of the September 24, 2012 meeting as recorded. Motion carried, minutes approved.

Public Forum Opened

REPORTS

Jeanine Klopp gave a report on the October 1, 2012 Planning Board meeting. Jeanine reported that Hamlin Meadows was scheduled a Public Hearing. Mr. and Mrs. Speer were referred to the Zoning Board for variances a subdivision on Moscow Rd. The Duffy Farmette subdivision was tabled until next month. Rochester Pallet and Crate was scheduled a Public Hearing. The Laszewski Subdivision on Ketchum Rd. was scheduled a Public Hearing. Mr. Sawyko received Conservation Development Permit approval for a garage addition on Newco Dr. Jeanine reported that the Ash Borer count was under way.

Nick Kramer gave a report on the October 15, 2012 Zoning Board meeting. Nick reported that Mr. and Mrs. Speer were scheduled a Public Hearing for a subdivision on Moscow Rd.

Ed Evans gave a report on the October 9, 2012 Town Board meeting. Ed reported that during the Public Forum the resident on the corner of Brick Schoolhouse Rd and Walker Lake Ontario Road requested that something be done to make the intersection safer. The town has sent a letter to the DOT requesting that a study be conducted. A resident on Wautoma Beach requested the Board change the code so she could sell items at her residence also. Highway Superintendent Steve Baase requested more money in his budget for field and park maintenance and other projects in the town. The Nov. 5 training session was approved for credit. Ed requested that the Board speak up so that everyone in the room can hear the meeting.

Dave Walch reported on the October 17, 2012 EMC meeting. Dave reported that there was a round table discussion. They reviewed check lists for other towns. They focused on the current landscaping on the lots.

Ed gave a report on HBSP. He didn't receive a report from the manager this month. Ed and Nick went to Niagara Falls to meet with the grandson of prisoner #1 from the CCC Camp. Recently prisoner #1 and #2 got together and met after 67 years. The manager has a plan for removing the existing sandstone from the CCC Camp site. The CCC Camp site is infested with beavers. They are taking down several trees and making a mess of the pond and drainage. 21 volunteers came to the recent work day at the camp to help. 7 new signs from the State are being put up. The work has begun on the camp grounds. Signs are up in the Park stating that the camp grounds are closed for construction. Lake Ontario is currently about 15" lower than this time last year. 41 new photos and newspapers were received and will be added to the museum. Merritt Ackles commented that at the end of Newco Dr. the beavers taken several trees down along the beach and at the entrance of Yanty Creek.
