SPRING CLEAN UP

This year we changed our spring cleanup from 2 weeks to one week but we are adding another week in the fall. We did this at the request of some residents who thought it would be beneficial to have 2 cleanups instead of one each year.

Town Residents will be allowed to bring their own items to 4180 Brick Schoolhouse Road (Transfer Station) Starting Saturday, April 25th through Sunday, May 3rd 2009. Weekday hours are from 10 a.m. - 7 p.m. and Weekend hours are 8 a.m. - 4 p.m.

There will also be available dumpsters for recycling at our spring cleanup. You will need to separate the paper, glass, and metal and put in the appropriate dumpster.

The Town of Hamlin will **NOT ACCEPT** any garbage, stones, concrete, paint cans, or hazardous waste items. On June 13th, Monroe County will be having a local Hazardous Waste pick-up, in the Town of Sweden. More information on registering for that day will be coming as we get closer to that date.

Any items containing a gas tank must have the gas tank removed before we will accept it. All gas tanks or drums must be clean, empty, and cut in half before we will accept them.

This year we will be collecting e waste which will be recycled by Sun King in Brockport. Below is a List of the items we will collect. The only items we will charge for are TVs and CRT monitors.

Items taken for a fee:

\$20.00 per item with Freon	\$10.00 per TV
\$ 2.50 per car tire	\$ 5.00 per CRT monitor

These items have to be paid for at the Town Clerk's Office before taking them to the Transfer Station. The Town Clerk's Office is open 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. We will accept cash, check, money order, Master Card, or Visa.

BRUSH PICK-UP

The Town of Hamlin will be doing the Spring Brush Pick-up starting **May 11th** through **May 15th**.

- * The Brush has to be cut into lengths of 8 feet or less.
- * Please pile the brush parallel with the road.
- * Please **Do Not** include any type of lumber.
- * Please **Do Not** intertwine piles. Brush has to be on the side of the road by **May 11th**.

The Town will **ONLY** make **ONE** pass down each road.

- * Only 2 (10 wheel truck loads) per owner
