Nicole successfully garnered a grant for \$1,500, which will be used to purchase a piece of playground equipment for disabled children. The recent Scout and Fire Department banquets also remind us of the many dedicated individuals, whose ongoing efforts make our Town a great place to live. So I say "thank you" to all of you who volunteer your time and effort or contribute financially to these efforts and all the other efforts, which benefit Hamlin.

Open Burning Prohibited

As we do our spring clean up, and as warmer weather approaches, it's a good time to remind everyone about the Town of Hamlin code regarding open burning. The burning of any refuse in an open fire is prohibited. The following types of open burning are permissible:

- a. Fires in outdoor grills and outdoor fireplaces for purpose of preparing food.
- b. Campfires and fires used for recreational purposes, when a nuisance is not created. The burning of leaves and lawn and garden debris is not considered recreational burning.
- c. Instructional or training burns of structures, when conducted under the control and supervision of qualified instructors for the training of firefighters.
- d. Agricultural burning, provided a burning permit has been obtained in advance from the Town Fire Marshal, when it is controlled and doesn't create a nuisance.

In the instance of campfires used for recreational purposes, follow all normal fire safety precautions and please be considerate of your neighbors. Any enforcement officer or fire department responding to open burning not permitted above, or that has been reported as a nuisance, is authorized to request any/all parties to extinguish the items being burned. If the parties refuse to do so, the fire department will extinguish the fire. Our open burning law was enacted to protect the property, public health, welfare and comfort of the residents and the air resources of the Town. Wind Tower Committee

Due to the extensive amount of work that must be done, the Wind Tower Committee voted to meet twice a month on the first and third Tuesdays (except for November 6, Election Day). The first meeting of the month will be a work session with no public forum. The public forum will be conducted at the second meeting. The committee has a very difficult and challenging task of assessing whether or not wind towers will be in the best interest of the Town and to develop regulations accordingly. Anyone wishing to speak for or against wind towers is invited to do so during the public forum conducted at the second meeting. BRUSH-GRASS-WEEDS

According to the Code of the Town of Hamlin, property owners are required to cut, trim or remove brush, grass, rubbish or weeds and to cut, trim, remove or destroy poisonous shrubs or weeds on their property. Failure to comply with this code can result in a violation notice. If you have any questions please contact the Building Department at 964-8181.



DOG CENSUS

For the year 2007 the Town of Hamlin will be conducting a complete dog census starting in May. If your dog is found to be unlicensed or your current license has not been renewed at the time of the census an additional fee of \$5.00 will be collected in addition to the licensing fee. SWIMMING POOL SAFETY

When the hot summer sun beats down, a swimming pool is very appealing. But because pools are attractive, they are potentially dangerous to young children. New York State building codes require pools to be fenced and gated and to be equipped with timers and alarms. If you are considering a swimming pool, hot tub or spa purchase contact the Hamlin Building Department first to obtain a permit and determine what requirements you must follow. The cost of the permit is \$25 and a final inspection is required before the pool can be used. An electrical inspection is necessary prior to the final inspection. Failure to obtain a permit will result in a \$125 fine plus the cost of the permit. Inground and above-ground pools, including inflatable pools holding more than 24 inches of water, must be surrounded by a fence or other barrier at least 4' high. Any gates in the fence must be self-closing and self-latching. A timer for the motor is also required. If a home's wall serves as part of the swimming pool's barrier, doors with direct access to the pool must be equipped with an alarm. These codes are in place for a reason. They are added safety measures to protect you, your neighbors and your guests from swimming pool accidents. As a pool owner you are responsible for anyone in your pool. Other things to consider when installing a pool include zoning requirements, electrical clearances and utility easements. The Hamlin Building Department also suggests contacting your insurance agent before installing a swimming pool. Most insurance companies require additional liability coverage. When opening an existing pool for the season, please remember that drainage procedures shall not interfere with the public water supply, existing drainage, sewage facilities, public highways, easements or the property of others.

BICYCLE SAFETY

Just a friendly reminder from the Code Enforcement Officer that protective head gear should be worn at all times for your safety. Children between the ages of one and fourteen that are on or operating a bicycle must wear a helmet. Children 14 and under that are using in-line skates, skateboards or scooters must also wear helmets.

As we approach summer please watch for an increased number of children riding bikes along the road and as always use caution for their safety. If riding at night make sure that the bike has reflectors so you can be seen by oncoming traffic. Bicyclists are required to follow motor vehicle rules of the road.

Mail-In and walk-in registration will be accepted in the Recreation Office starting on March, 19th 2007. If a program is cancelled due to low enrollment, all registered participants will be notified.
