## FIRE MARSHAL'S CORNER



It's that time of the year again to change your batteries in your Smoke Detectors and Carbon Monoxide Detectors. Smoke detectors shall be installed in the following locations:

- In each sleeping room
- Outside of each sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedroom (Within 15 Feet)
- On each additional story of the dwelling, including the basement area

Carbon Monoxide Detectors must be installed in a dwelling unit or sleeping unit that contains a carbon monoxide source, a carbon monoxide alarm shall be provided on the lowest story that contains a sleeping area. The carbon monoxide alarm shall be located within 15 feet of the sleeping area. More than one carbon monoxide alarm shall be provided where necessary to assure that no sleeping area on such story is more than 15 feet away from a carbon monoxide alarm. In addition a carbon monoxide alarm shall be provided within each sleeping area that contains a carbon monoxide source.

Carbon monoxide sources:

- Any appliance, equipment, device or system that emit carbon monoxide (including, but not limited to, fuel fired furnaces, fuel fired boilers, space heaters with pilot lights or open flames, kerosene heaters, wood stoves, fireplaces, and stoves, ovens, dryers, water heaters and refrigerators that use a gas or liquid fuel)
- Any residents with an attached garage must have a carbon monoxide alarm in the home.

### PAST AND PRESENT NEWS FROM THE NORTH STAR HISTORY CENTER Bob Kruger, Hamlin Town Historian—964-7385

As spring begins to make an appearance, the sight of green grass and trees starting to bud makes our thoughts turn to outdoor activities. This not only includes yard work and property maintenance but also leisure and recreational activities as well.

With approximately ten miles of lake shore, the Hamlin waterfront over the years has offered fishing, boating and during the late 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries, a resort community known as Troutburg, that flourished with summer activities. With the glory days of Troutburg long passed, Hamlin Beach State Park, is right at our door step. Swimming, hiking, picnicking and camping are only a few of the things to do within the Park's approximately 1,200 acres and three and half miles of shore.

Also, located just off Moscow Road is the grounds' of the former CCC/POW Camp. It is owned by the State, but was mostly developed and is maintained by "The Friends of Hamlin Beach State Park", a kiosk provides information to guide you through the camp and help you visualize what life was like on the site in the 1930's and 40's.

Our Town offers a number of activities and programs through the Recreation Department and the Hamlin Seniors group to get involved in through-out the spring and summer months.

This year, starting June 17<sup>th</sup>, through the end of August, the North Star History Center will be open on Wednesdays from 6pm –8pm. People will be invited to look at the displays and ask questions. We will also have for sale a large number of surplus genealogy periodicals and books that were recently donated.

If you have an urge this summer season to start looking for your ancestors and wonder how to get started, these materials might be just the thing to start reading while sitting in a lawn chair with a cold glass of lemonade.

THINK OF A BUILDING PERMIT AS A SAFETY NET. IT MAKES SURE THAT THE INFORMATION PERTAINING TO YOUR PROPERTY IS CORRECT. IT CHECKS YOUR ZONING CLASSIFICATION TO SEE WHAT IS ALLOWED OR PERMITTED IN YOUR ZONE. IT ALSO CAN DIRECT YOU IF YOU MAY NEED A VARIANCE OR A SITE PLAN. IT ALSO REQUIRES A SET OF PLANS FOR THE BUILDING INSPECTOR TO REVIEW AND KEEP ON FILE FOR REFERENCE.

Come join our Community Garden club in creating our very own garden in the Hamlin Town Park! In addition we will be learning how to create a Straw Bale Garden.




Straw Bale gardening is great because it involves no tilling, weeding, or fertilizing. It also doesn't matter whether the soil has drained or not.




