

## FIRE MARSHAL'S CORNER



### 6 Fire Safety Tips for Kids

Teach kids how to prevent a fire and stay safe in case of fire with these important tips.

1. **Don't play with matches.** In fact, don't even pick them up. If you find matches or a lighter on the floor, be sure to tell an adult. This goes for a lit candle, too.
2. **Check your house for smoke detectors.** There should be at least one on every floor of your home. And ask your parents when the batteries were last changed. Most fire departments recommend changing batteries twice a year, **(In the fall when you set your clocks back and in the spring when you set them forward).**
3. **Check your house for fire hazards.** Fireplaces and electrical cords should be checked regularly to make sure they are in good working order. If there is an adult in the home that smokes, make sure that they disposes of the ashes frequently in a heavy metal container.
4. **Make a family fire safety plan.** What should you do if you hear the smoke alarm in the middle of the night? Talk to your family about where you should go and what you should all do in the event of a fire. There should be two ways to escape from every room (in case one way is blocked by fire.) And you should pick a location outside, a neighbor's house, a big tree or a nearby park where everyone can meet.
5. **Practice your fire safety plan.** Don't just talk about it, run through your plan to make sure everyone knows what to do. Check windows and screens to make sure that they will open if necessary. And practice meeting up at your assigned location outside.
6. **If there is a fire in your home,** remember this important fire safety tip: **Don't hide, go outside!** You may be scared, but never hide during a fire. Get outside and wait for your parents or caregivers at your assigned spot. **NEVER GO BACK INSIDE.**

Tucked away in the northeastern portion of the town of Hamlin, at the corner of Church Road and Walker Lake Ontario Road, is located the North Star History Center. The History Center which started out as a one room school house and was, at one time, one of 15 active school houses in the town will be open on Wednesdays from 7-9 pm starting April 6th, 2016 and of course by appointment as well. Please call (585) 964-7385 (office) or (585)727-3855 to schedule a tour or just to come in to browse and learn.

The History Center is always interested in donations of old photographs or artifacts which would enhance the current collection. We are also seeking senior citizens who have been lifelong citizens of Hamlin who would not mind sharing their individual stories of what it was like growing up in Hamlin to be recorded for future generations to enjoy.

My name is Dave Walch and I was appointed by Town Supervisor Eric Peters at the beginning of the year to the position of Town Historian. I am still in the process of learning the job and in future Hamlin Express issues I will submit articles on a specific aspect of Hamlin's history which you will hopefully find to be of interest. I do want to provide a personal, "Thank you," to Mary E. Smith, long time town historian and who now holds the title of Hamlin Town Historian Emeritus, who has become an invaluable resource and a mentor for me.




## Our Mission Statement




