As I write this article, it is two weeks after Hurricane Sandy landed upon the Northeast and specifically the Town of Hamlin. While the circumstances involved with Hurricane Sandy thankfully did not result in major loss of property or any loss of life, it does bring the issue of emergency preparedness to the forefront. On the night of October 29th, in conjunction with the Monroe County Office of Emergency Preparedness, I issued a "State of Emergency" for the Town of Hamlin, with orders to evacuate homes on the lakeshore. Monroe County followed up with automated phone calls to residents in the affected area requesting that they evacuate.

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Finally, for United States Armed Forces Veterans and their families, the Town of Hamlin has added a "Veteran's Services" page to our website. This page is designed to be a one stop information center for all benefits and services provided by the Town, County and State to our Veterans. NYS Dog Licensing



Dog Licensing – NYS Agriculture & Markets Law states that a dog 4 months old must be licensed. If Dog Control responds to a complaint and finds the dog is unlicensed, an appearance ticket will be issued. The fine is \$75.00 for the first offense and if you have more than 1 dog, it's \$75 per dog.

If you are sent a renewal form for your dog's license and you don't renew it, there is a \$75.00 fine for the first violation and up to \$250.00 for the second and each subsequent violation.

There is NO Fostering allowed in the Town of Hamlin without a Special Use Permit. If you have a dog in your home, you must license it as it is considered your dog. If you have over 3 dogs in your home, you need a Harboring Dog Permit for a one time fee of \$25.00.

Unspayed/  
Unneutered \$17.00

The Town of Hamlin will be doing a Dog Census after the first of the year. If you have an unlicensed dog when someone comes to your door during the census, there will be a charge of \$25.00 for each dog that is unlicensed.

From the Assessor's Office

Well, it's that time of year again: cold temperatures, the smell of pine trees, hot chocolate, Christmas lights and family gatherings. Here in the Assessor's Office, this time of year brings the beginning stages of preparing the 2013 Tax Roll. Since the Town went to "Full Market" assessment values in 2010, the goal of the Town and Assessor's Office has been to manage and maintain assessments to represent a 100% equalization rate. This basically means that property assessments should represent "minimally" what a property should sell for on the open market.

As your Assessor, it is never my intention to over assess your property. Unfortunately, at times "some" properties do sell for less than their current assessments and adjustments can be made to those property assessments based on their sale price. On the positive side, "most" properties do sell for more than their assessments and based on those sale prices adjustments are also made.

As we work on the 2013 Tax Roll, many assessments will be adjusted, as it has been three years since the last overall adjustment. Assessment notices will be mailed out late March/early April 2013 to notify the property owners of properties that have been adjusted. If you do receive an assessment notice and you do not agree with your new assessment, or just have questions, please contact the Assessor's Office at 964-8748 to set up an appointment to discuss your assessment.

This is also the time of year when Tax Exemption Renewal applications and New Tax Exemption applications are starting to be entered on the 2013 Tax Roll. Applications for all exemptions, Renewal or New, must be filed with the Assessor's Office by March 1st, 2013 to receive a tax credit for the 2013 tax year. The Assessor's Office has mailed out the Enhanced STAR renewal applications and they may be renewed by mail or in person with a copy of your 2011 tax return. If you receive the Low Income/Senior Citizen exemption, we will be mailing out the renewal applications the last week of December. They also may be renewed by mail or in person with a copy of your 2012 tax return or income statements. Residents who already have the Basic STAR exemption do not need to reapply unless you have moved.

Any resident who may be turning 65 years of age anytime during the year 2013, please stop into the Assessor's Office or call us at 964-8748 before March 1st, 2013 so we can evaluate your exemptions and possibly upgrade them and save you more money.

I personally would like to invite any resident into our office when they feel they are unfairly assessed. The opportunity gives me and you, the homeowner, the chance to review the property inventory and the condition of the property and make adjustments if necessary. Our regular office hours are 9:00 am – 3:00 pm Monday through Friday, but "assessment review" meetings may be scheduled anytime Monday through Saturday.

If you're interested in purchasing a property in the Town of Hamlin, please call the Assessor's Office at 964-8748 for information such as: current assessment, estimated taxes, property description, prior sales information, or any filed assessment grievances about the property.

The Assessor's office is always willing to help current and new residents to the Town of Hamlin with any questions they may have. As residents continue to invest in properties within the Town of Hamlin, my goal as the Assessor is to make sure each resident understands their property assessment and feel they are being assessed fairly.

NYS Dog Licensing



Dog Licensing – NYS Agriculture & Markets Law states that a dog 4 months old must be licensed. If Dog Control responds to a complaint and finds the dog is unlicensed, an appearance ticket will be issued. The fine is \$75.00 for the first offense and if you have more than 1 dog, it's \$75 per dog.

If you are sent a renewal form for your dog's license and you don't renew it, there is a \$75.00 fine for the first violation and up to \$250.00 for the second and each subsequent violation.

There is NO Fostering allowed in the Town of Hamlin without a Special Use Permit. If you have a dog in your home, you must license it as it is considered your dog. If you have over 3 dogs in your home, you need a Harboring Dog Permit for a one time fee of \$25.00.

The Town of Hamlin will be doing a Dog Census after the first of the year. If you have an unlicensed dog when someone comes to your door during the census, there will be a charge of \$25.00 for each dog that is unlicensed.

From the Assessor's Office

Well, it's that time of year again: cold temperatures, the smell of pine trees, hot chocolate, Christmas lights and family gatherings. Here in the Assessor's Office, this time of year brings the beginning stages of preparing the 2013 Tax Roll. Since the Town went to "Full Market" assessment values in 2010, the goal of the Town and Assessor's Office has been to manage and maintain assessments to represent a 100% equalization rate. This basically means that property assessments should represent "minimally" what a property should sell for on the open market.

As your Assessor, it is never my intention to over assess your property. Unfortunately, at times "some" properties do sell for less than their current assessments and adjustments can be made to those property assessments based on their sale price. On the positive side, "most" properties do sell for more than their assessments and based on those sale prices adjustments are also made.

As we work on the 2013 Tax Roll, many assessments will be adjusted, as it has been three years since the last overall adjustment. Assessment notices will be mailed out late March/early April 2013 to notify the property owners of properties that have been adjusted. If you do receive an assessment notice and you do not agree with your new assessment, or just have questions, please contact the Assessor's Office at 964-8748 to set up an appointment to discuss your assessment.

This is also the time of year when Tax Exemption Renewal applications and New Tax Exemption applications are starting to be entered on the 2013 Tax Roll. Applications for all exemptions, Renewal or New, must be filed with the Assessor's Office by March 1st, 2013 to receive a tax credit for the 2013 tax year. The Assessor's Office has mailed out the Enhanced STAR renewal applications and they may be renewed by mail or in person with a copy of your 2011 tax return. If you receive the Low Income/Senior Citizen exemption, we will be mailing out the renewal applications the last week of December. They also may be renewed by mail or in person with a copy of your 2012 tax return or income statements. Residents who already have the Basic STAR exemption do not need to reapply unless you have moved.

Any resident who may be turning 65 years of age anytime during the year 2013, please stop into the Assessor's Office or call us at 964-8748 before March 1st, 2013 so we can evaluate your exemptions and possibly upgrade them and save you more money.

I personally would like to invite any resident into our office when they feel they are unfairly assessed. The opportunity gives me and you, the homeowner, the chance to review the property inventory and the condition of the property and make adjustments if necessary. Our regular office hours are 9:00 am – 3:00 pm Monday through Friday, but "assessment review" meetings may be scheduled anytime Monday through Saturday.

If you're interested in purchasing a property in the Town of Hamlin, please call the Assessor's Office at 964-8748 for information such as: current assessment, estimated taxes, property description, prior sales information, or any filed assessment grievances about the property.

The Assessor's office is always willing to help current and new residents to the Town of Hamlin with any questions they may have. As residents continue to invest in properties within the Town of Hamlin, my goal as the Assessor is to make sure each resident understands their property assessment and feel they are being assessed fairly.
