

Hamlin Planning Board *Minutes*
Workshop
April 1, 2008

The Hamlin Planning Board Workshop was held at the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Road, Hamlin, New York and was called to order by Chairperson Linda Morey at 7:00pm.

Present: Dane Emens, Judith Hazen, Tom Jensen, Linda Morey and Chris Schlieter.

Also present: Supervisor Denny Roach, Highway Superintendent Tom Ingraham, Support Boards Attorney Charlie Welch and several interested residents.

DISCUSSION

Department of Transportation Representative Dave Goehring was present to discuss concerns along Roosevelt Highway regarding speed limit and possible access alternatives for the Heritage Woods Subdivision that is being proposed. Mr. Goehring stated that the DOT has received a letter from the Hamlin Town Board regarding a possible speed reduction along Roosevelt Highway and they would be conducting a study in the next couple of months. The character of the road, local law enforcement, signage and pavement conditions would also be looked at. Possible other access locations for the Heritage Woods Subdivision were discussed. Mr. Goehring stated that site distance is the most important factor when determining access location. It was discussed that some trees along the south side of the road may need to be trimmed or removed to gain better site distance. Having a "T" intersection was discussed. Mr. Goehring explained that having a "T" intersection in that location would cause more conflict for drivers and there would be no benefit. It was also stated that the location does not warrant a signal light either. Mr. Goehring answered questions from Board members and the Highway Superintendent.

Chairman Linda Morey thanked Mr. Goehring for coming.
