

Hamlin Town Board Meeting
February 12, 2007

The regular scheduled meeting of the Hamlin Town Board was held in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Rd., Hamlin, New York. The meeting was called to order at 7 pm by Town Supervisor Dennis Roach who explained the location of the fire exits and defibrillator for those present. Everyone participated in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and a Moment of Silence for all deceased residents of Hamlin.

PUBLIC FORUM

Julie Lloyd from the American Cancer Society gave a quick presentation on the "Relay for Life" in Spencerport June 1-2, 2007 and hoped to get a couple of teams from Hamlin. This event is to help raise money for Cancer and to get people involved. Julie is here to spread the word and around the time for the Relay would like to have purple ribbons and t-shirts in the windows of storeowners and around flagpoles etc.

Stan Lyons, Recreation Commissioner stated that they were approached at the spaghetti dinner by Rick Sercu from the Hilton Snow Flyers regarding Snow Day, March 4th and asked if they could bring a couple of snowmobiles and give rides. We are aware that there are signs posted for NO Snowmobile on Town Property. We would mark off a route for them.

Councilperson Todd commented that they do this for other communities as well. He has a friend in Churchville and they come out there with the same thing. Code Enforcement Officer B.J Maier stated they also do that in Parma.

Supervisor Roach stated that our policy is no snowmobiles on Town Property and wanted the Town Board to know of this request. If we allow this we are going against our own policy and are we then setting a precedent? If something happened would we be liable?

Councilperson Rath does not have a problem waiving our restrictions for that 1-day. The Snow Flyers do a good job promoting snowmobiles in Town with the making of the trails and keeping the machines away from the houses. New York State doesn't require you to belong to a club but it is very beneficial that you do.

B.J. Maier stated that in Parma they had 1-2 snowmobiles and then he asked if they would want Walker's off-road vehicles. Councilperson Rose asked about a precedent being made. Attorney Licht stated that he didn't believe so as you're stating a date and time. Supervisor Roach would also like the route to be as far away from the homes on Apple Hollow Lane and Roosevelt Highway so it doesn't bother the residents.

WAIVING OF SNOWMOBILE POLICY ON TOWN PROPERTY FOR SNOW DAY MARCH 4, 2007

Resolution # 87 Motion was made by Councilman Rath, seconded by Councilman Todd to waive the snow mobile policy on town property for March 4th from 12 noon till 4 pm for Recreation's Snow Day. Only two Snowmobiles from the Hilton Snow Flyers Club will be allowed to be on town property. They must also provide a Certificate of Insurance. Members polled, Councilperson Marchetti aye, Councilperson Rath aye, Councilperson Rose aye, Councilperson Todd aye and Supervisor Roach aye. Motion Carried.

PUBLIC FORUM (CONTINUED)

Troy Nesbitt from Cook Road asked if they would be able to speak during the discussion segment of the meeting regarding a moratorium on Wind Towers? Supervisor Roach stated no this would be the time.

Mr. Nesbitt stated that he would hope the Town Board would consider very seriously putting a moratorium on Wind Towers so that the committee could finish their work.

PUBLIC HEARING FOR AMENDING SECTION 125-76 (A)(1), ZBA MEMBERS

Supervisor Roach opened the public hearing by reading Section 125-76(A)(1) of the Hamlin Zoning Law of 1991 to reduce the number of Zoning Boards Members from seven to five and adding a new subparagraph that no incumbent shall be removed from office except upon the expiration of his or her term. Proof of publication was provided by the Town Clerk. The floor was opened for public comments.

Norman Baase, Chairperson of the Zoning Board, stated that the Board has no problems with this and they know that once you go to 5 members you can't go back to 7 per the State regulations. They would like to have alternates though. Supervisor Roach stated that you are allowed alternates.

CLOSING THE PUBLIC HEARING ON AMENDING SECTION 125-76(A)(1), ZBA MEMBERS AT 7:20PM

PUBLIC HEARING FOR AMENDING SECTION 125-12(A)(2)(1) AND 125-9

Supervisor Roach opened the public hearing to amend Section 125-21(A)(2)(1) and 125-9 Definition of the Hamlin Zoning Law of 1991 to delete the word condominium and delete condominium as a defined term. Proof of publication was provided by the Town Clerk. The floor was opened for comments.

Karen Jensen of 1 Roadside Drive asked what is wrong with the word condominium, why do we have to take it out.

Supervisor Roach stated that was a good question. The word Condominium is a form of ownership not a use and it's in our zoning regulation. Zoning Regulations have to do with use variances and area variances. So we don't see any reason to confuse people more by having it in the definitions.

REPORTS

Councilperson George Todd reported that the Seniors Trip Schedule for next year is complete for those of us who are eligible.

Councilperson Mike Marchetti reported on the Dog Control Officer and that he is still trying to familiarize himself with the office. He is also having a little problem with the computer but likes what he is doing and has no complaints. Chuck Mosele will be doing a presentation on the United Way on March 5th -9th. Hamlin Ambulance had 505 calls last year, it went up 6% from last year. The Volunteer Ambulance responded to 80% of the calls for the year. Hilton/Parma is having a public meeting on a new firehouse, which he will be attending and will report back.

Highway Sup. Tom Ingraham stated that the Oil-Water separator came in. He will be gone March 6th and 7th for Advocacy Day in Albany. Nicole Sercu has received a grant through Monroe County Youth Bureau for approximately \$2,000.00 to install a handicap swing on the playground.

Code Enforcement Officer B.J. Maier reported on C-of-O's this month and the enforcement of the junk cars is working. Also working with Assessor on open permits.

Assessor Melanie Fahmer was invited to speak to the seniors about the existing senior exemption and there was quite a group that day. There is a possibility of an extended Star Program. Reminder that March 1st is the deadline for applications.

Councilperson Paul Rath stated that a meeting with the Fire Department Chiefs is scheduled for 7pm, February 28.

Councilperson Dave Rose gave a report on the Library count per day in 2004 was 75, 2005 was 89, and in 2006 up to 106. Opening for a Trustee, will be published in the paper. Munchkin Mondays for ages 2-5 is going very well. In regards to the Planning Board they approved Lot #2 on the south side for the road. Still wants to keep that as a separate tax account number. Kevin Truelson would like to have a furniture store in the plaza and a single family home was approved for 808 Wiler Road.

Supervisor Roach noted that the proposed revised Town's Emergency/Disaster Plan is out for review. Inputs are due by March 15th.

Supervisor Roach received a call from a resident on Roosevelt Highway who requests that the farmers be asked to retain hedge rows to help prevent drifting snow.

Supervisor Roach announced that our fire safety program received a grant in the amount of \$1,000.00 from the State. Well done to Chuck Mosele, Assistant Fire Marshal for his efforts with the grants.
