

PUBLIC HEARING
Revised Fee Schedule
June 11, 2007

A public hearing was held in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Rd., Hamlin, New York. The hearing was opened at 6:45 pm by Supervisor Dennis Roach.

Present: Supervisor Dennis Roach, Councilperson Paul Rath, Councilperson David Rose and Councilperson George Todd

Also present: Code Enforcement Officer B. J. Maier, Planning Bd. Member Tom Jensen, Attorney Ken Licht, Conservation Bd. Member Tom Breslawski, Assessor Melanie Fahmer, Residents Lloyd Lochner, Nancy Jennejahn

Supervisor Roach explained for those present that this was a courtesy public hearing to review the administrative fee schedule. This is not a local law therefore a public hearing is not required but the board felt as a courtesy to the public a hearing would be held to hear public testimony. A copy of the legal notice is located on the agenda. Further explained by Supervisor Roach were some additions to the list of fees such as permits are now required for generators and re-roofing. He also noted for clarification that under the antenna or satellite dish, the satellite dish is for above six feet and free standing and not for the smaller dishes. If adopted the fees for projects that are in progress would remain at the current fee.

The floor was opened for public testimony. There were no public comments. Supervisor Roach then stated he would recommend for discussion at the time consideration for adoption was held that the Special Use Permits/Renewals and Professional Office Permits/Renewals be increased to \$30.00 as it has remained the same for many years. Councilperson Todd asked Code Enforcement Officer B. J. Maier if there are many of the larger satellite dishes in town. A reply was approximately six remain.

Barring no further comments the public hearing was closed at 6:50 pm.
