

PUBLIC HEARING
RE: REZONING 1678 LAKE ROAD
April 11, 2011

The Hamlin Town Board held a Public Hearing in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Road, Hamlin, New York to consider rezoning the property at 1678 Lake Road from C-GB (Commercial General Business) to R-M (Residential Medium Density).
