

Hamlin Public Hearing  
January 12, 2015

The Hamlin Town Board held a Public Hearing in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Road, Hamlin, New York. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Supervisor Peters.

Present: Councilperson Jason Baxter, Councilperson Jennifer Goodrich, Councilperson Martin Maier, Councilperson David Rose, and Supervisor Eric Peters. Also present: Highway Superintendent Steve Baase, Attorney Ken Leicht, Building Inspector Cheryl Pacelli, Patrick Fitzgerald, Krupakaran Kolandaivelu, Eugene Dollard, Marci Dollard, Robert Sengillo, Susan Marino, James Peters.

**PUBLIC HEARING RE: SPECIAL USE PERMIT APPLICATION**

Supervisor Peters briefly discussed the Public Hearing was to consider a special use permit for New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") request to install and operate a new wireless communications facility at 100 Moscow Road, Hamlin, New York 14464 (SBL# 6.02-1-4)("Site")

Pat Fitzgerald and Krupakaran Kolandaivelu presented on the behalf of ATT. They indicated that they went through an extensive site selection process to determine where this tower should be located. They showed maps that indicated the proposed coverage area which was based on insufficient current coverage. They are asking for a relief of 4 feet of height of the mono pole based on the current code. There will be an access driveway that will be from the East Fork Lake Road. There will be available parking for the trucks to get in and out and there will be a small equipment shelter.

**PUBLIC QUESTIONS**

It was asked if it will be able to handle more antennas to be added in the future. Sue Marino indicated that she would recommend that the pole and foundation be designed for three additional carriers in the future so that reconstruction would not have to be done at a later date if more carriers do decide to add. It was asked if there would be any other security measures other than the 8 foot fence. It was asked how long it would be until the tower would be put up after the approval is given. It is unknown at this time as several other vendors will be involved to get the whole process completed.

**PUBLIC HEARING CLOSED**

Resolution #42 Motion was made by Councilperson Baxter, seconded by Councilperson Goodrich, requesting Town Board resolution to close the Public Hearing regarding a special use permit to install and operate a new wireless communications facility at 100 Moscow Road, Hamlin, NY at 6:47 PM as all business was concluded.
