

Hamlin Zoning Board of Appeals *Minutes*
Monday, January 21, 2008

The regular scheduled meeting of the Hamlin Zoning Board of Appeals was held in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Road, Hamlin and was called to order by Chairman Norman Baase at 7:30pm with the location of the fire exits and AED explained for those present.

Town Board Liaison Mike Marchetti stated that the Town Board would be meeting with Attorney Spitzer tomorrow night at 6:00pm to go over Wind Tower regulations. There will be a special Town Board Public Hearing on Feb. 7 at St. John's Church for the Wind Tower Law.

Conservation Board member Craig Goodrich stated that he attended the last EMC meeting and the new Head of the DEC discussed several issues that he would like to attack but they have a money issue also. The Conversationist Magazine will be handed out to all 4 or 5 graders in NYS. They will be addressing Environmental Justice. Treating everyone the same. They would be addressing recycling, green house gases, money for upgrading infrastructures in New York and looking into banning outside wood boilers in congested areas.
