

Hamlin Zoning Board of Appeals *Minutes*

Barbara Quinn and Raymond Marciszewski were present seeking relief from Town Code 125-31C(4) for a 26% impervious surface variance to construct an 8' x 21' porch on their house located at 5800 Wautoma Beach Road. Mr. Marciszewski stated that he needed this variance because he would exceed the impervious surface per the code but he really didn't understand because other lots around him have similar situations. Attorney Welch explained the code and the reason for the impervious surface requirement.

A motion was made by Jerry Hoffman, seconded by Ed Haight to schedule a Public Hearing for Barbara Quinn and Raymond Marciszewski seeking relief from Town Code 125-31C(4) for a 26% impervious surface variance for an 8' x 21' porch located at 5800 Wautoma Beach for July 20, 2009 at 7:30pm. Members polled, Baase aye, Ellsworth aye, Haight aye, Hoffman aye, Pohl aye. Motion carried.

The Board reminded them to have their fees into the Clerk by July 6, 2009 and to have the location staked out for an on site inspection on July 18, 2009.
