

UNAPPROVED MINUTES MARCH 27 2018  
HAMLIN SENIORS GENERAL MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 11:47 by President Ron Klein with the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag, followed by a moment of silence.

President Klein read the March birthdays and anniversaries and "Happy Birthday and "Happy Anniversary" was sung by all.

He reminded members to please take time during or after the meal to read the minutes from February so we could move right into the meeting after we eat. Because Coordinator Michelle Johnson is unable to be here for the business meeting, she gave her report at this time, showing us the size of pickle or olive jars that will be needed for the April craft, asking that members save and bring clean jars of that size to the next meeting. She also reminded us that, as a part of their membership, ALL members are asked to volunteer at least once each year to help the kitchen crew set up and take down after our monthly meals, except for those months when we either have a catered meal here (May and November) or go elsewhere for our meeting and meal (August and December). The months of July and September have NO people signed up to help, so helpers are needed for those months. Michelle also reminded those who do sign up that they should come to St John at 9:30 am in order to help with coffee making, filling and placing of water and lemonade urns, setting out coffee supplies, getting hot pads and serving spoons on the buffet table, cutting up bread and any desserts to be served, and then clearing the buffet and beverage tables and helping to put the kitchen back in order.

Michelle also said she is beginning to take sign ups for the National Senior Month catered meal in May. The meal is free to members who have attended a previous catered meal; otherwise there is a one-time charge.

Sue Reynolds is the Senior of the Month; there are no new members this month.

At this time, Pastor Chris Bode gave the prayer and our meal was enjoyed by all.

President Klein reconvened the meeting at 12:50 pm.
